

Spa services

If you would like your pet bathed before going home, please let us know at check in. We will bathe your pet the morning of check out and your pet will be ready to go home after 3pm. Included with the bath is ear cleaning, anal glands and a pedicure. We do not cut or trim hair but can refer your pet to Glamour Paws for additional salon services.

Our Facilities

Canine guests are kept in a cage or run, depending on the size of the pet. Each comes furnished with blankets and food and water bowls. We have a covered outdoor patio for our doggie guests to enjoy several times during the day. All of our cages are indoors.

Our feline guests stay in our cat room, which is located right off our lobby. From there, kitties can gaze out the window or lounge about on one of our cat trees.

From I-30 West:

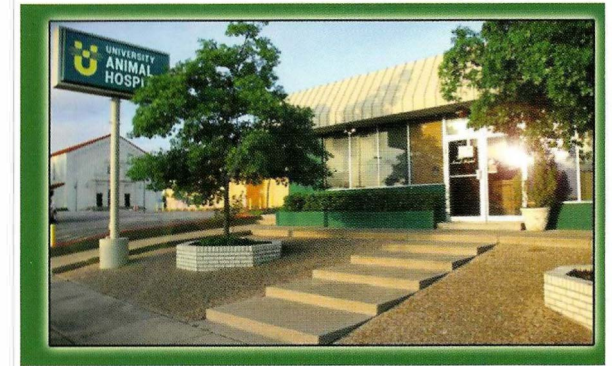
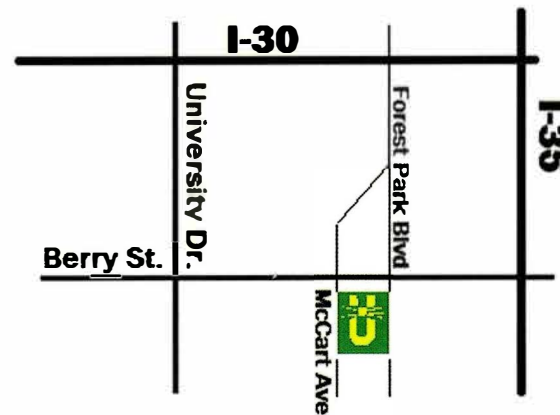
Exit Forest Park Blvd. Head south on Forest Park Blvd for 1.5 miles. Take a slight right and Forest Park turns into McCart Avenue. Continue for 0.8 mile and we are just past Berry Street on the left.

From I-35W:

Exit Berry Street. Head west on Berry street for 2 miles. Turn left onto McCart Avenue.

From University Drive:

Head south on University Drive. Turn left onto Berry Street. Continue for 0.5 mile and turn right onto McCart Avenue.

Check In/Check Out

Check in hours for boarding are between 8:00 am and 5:45 pm Monday through Friday, and 9:00 am and 11:45 am Saturdays. Check out is any time during our regular business hours. There is no check in or check out on Sundays or holidays. If you wish to have a friend or relative pick up your pet, please let us know .



Toys and Bedding

You are welcome to bring toys and personal items to make your pet's stay more comfortable but please be aware that some items may be lost or may not go home in the same condition.

Diet

We feed Purina Veterinary Diets formula EN to all of our boarding guests. If your pet has special dietary requirements, we will be happy to accommodate his or her needs. You will need to bring any special diet along with your pet.

Should Your Pet Become Ill

One of the advantages of boarding your pet at a veterinary hospital is that medical attention is readily available should the need arise. We closely monitor all boarding pets for changes in appetite, elimination and behavior. Any change is reported to our veterinarians and we will then try to contact you to authorize treatment.

Pets With Special Needs

We also provide care for pets with special circumstances such as blindness, diabetes, kidney failure or recent surgery. Please be sure to bring enough of your pet's medications for the duration of his/her stay.

Required Vaccinations:

To help prevent the spread of infectious or contagious disease within our facility, all pets must have had a physical exam, been completely immunized and tested negative for intestinal parasites and heartworms within the past 12 months. We ask for proof of vaccination upon check in to our clinic.

Dogs: Exam, DHPP, Bordetella, Rabies, fecal and heartworm test, *bivalent flu*

Cats: Exam, FDVRTC, Rabies and fecal test

If your pet is overdue for any of these procedures they will be administered upon arrival. Pets with external parasites will be bathed and dipped or have Capstar administered at the owner's expense.
